1.	Meeting Formalities
1.1	Opening of meeting
2.	Discussion regarding motion of no confidence brought against the SAEF
	<p>A 38 page document citing the reasons for a motion of no confidence against the SAEF and a request for a Special General meeting was sent to all discipline presidents, asking for mandates in favour of the motion of no confidence and request for an SGM.</p> <p>Some disciplines have requested supporting evidence of the allegations made in the 38 page document, no supporting evidence was received. Threats were made that if the document was circulated & the threats proved to be unfounded, that members circulating the document could be legally pursued for defamation and spreading of false information. The president has circulated the document to MAASA council to discuss but does not feel comfortable circulating this document to all MAASA members due to threats of defamation.</p> <p>MAASA council needs to decide how to proceed.</p> <p>Decision taken: The council decided not to circulate this document to MAASA members and athletes in order to avoid potential legal action. Council therefore decided not to support the Motion of no confidence, but agreed to support the request for a special general meeting so that both sides of the allegations can be heard.</p> <p>The president is to draft a letter in response to the motion of no confidence and send to the council for approval before emailing the official response.</p>
3.	IHAA wGP 2021 Team Selection
	<p>Since very few qualifiers were completed and no nationals were held in 2020 due to Covid, the MAASA council needed to adjust selection criteria in order to select teams for the IHAA wGP2021. The scores of all competing athlete's last 5 competitions (Nationals 2019, Q1 2020, IHAA wGP 2020 and Q1&2 2021), were collated and sent to council to review. Of the 5 competitions, the scores of the best 3 competitions for each rider were used in order to determine an average score and HA level attained per event as well as an average overall HA level. Using these results, it was determined which adults which juniors are eligible for team selection.</p> <p>MAASA would like to enter 2 teams this year; Adult Open Team and Junior Young Rider (up to 21 years)</p> <p>Each team to consist of 9 riders. If there aren't 9 eligible riders available some riders may be asked to ride in two stages. A team has to consist of a minimum of 5 riders of which 4 may compete in 2 stages.</p> <p>The senior team has enough eligible riders to make up the team of 9.</p> <p>For the Junior Young Rider team there are 7 juniors eligible for selection, shooting on average on HA level. The 2 top riders will compete twice to make up the team of 9.</p> <p>Council had a discussion about whether to give 2 Student Archer riders the opportunity to take part. After carefully and objectively considering all options and reviewing MAASA rules and selection criteria Council resolved to only select riders who shot an average of HA level across their 3 best competitions for this international competition.</p>
