Various countries have received invitations. Confirmations have been received from the Kazakhs, Russians, Mongolians and Hungarians. • Horses: 20 to 30 additional horses will be needed. Looking into possibly using Moolmanshoek horses and available older tentpeppers. There will be strict rules regarding the horses and safety regulations. • Everyone will be accommodated in tented camps • Competition will start at first light and enough helpers will be needed in order to get through all the events and smooth running of the competition. • Special Outfits can be worn but it's not a requirement. Each country has been asked to bring some traditional hats to exchange with each other
